

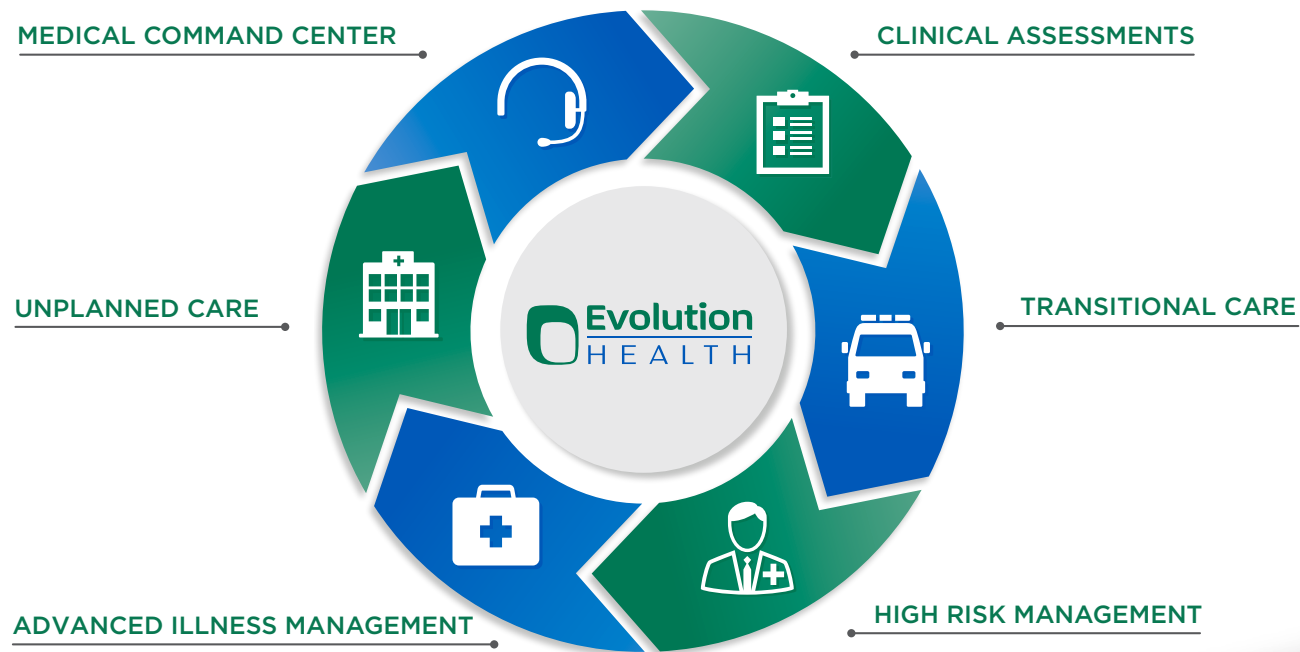

CASE STUDY:

Treating Comorbidity Patients with Integrated Care



SITUATION



Patient

- 83-year-old male with a past medical history of atrial fibrillation, congestive heart failure (CHF), and hypertension (HTN).



Condition

- The patient had two hospitalizations in the last six months both for CHF exacerbation.



Call

- Twelve days after hospital discharge, the patient called the Medical Command Center (MCC) complaining of mild upper abdomen pain radiating to the chest and dizziness.



CARE PLAN



Initial Triage

- The Mobile Integrated Healthcare paramedic was dispatched to assess the patient. The paramedic connected with the on-duty MIH Physician Assistant (PA) at the MCC via telemedicine to perform a real-time comprehensive assessment.



Diagnosis

- The patient had CHF related diarrhea and dehydration.



Actionable Treatment

- The patient was treated symptomatically with over-the-counter (OTC) antacids, antiemetics and proton pump inhibitors prescribed by telephone to his local pharmacy.



OUTCOMES



Results

- Due to the interventions of the MIH team, the patient avoided the emergency department.



Cost & Time Savings

- The MIH team's intervention reduced unnecessary utilization of high cost hospitalization.
